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Terms and Conditions

These terms and conditions are in accordance with Woking Shopmobility Insurance Policy No. TS5/4737680/060099.

I hereby undertake to comply with the following conditions: -

1. To take due care of the vehicle whilst in my care and not to leave it unattended at any time unless safely parked out of the way of pedestrians with the key removed.
2. To exercise due care and attention at all times whilst using the wheelchair or scooter and not to use a mobile phone unless stationary. In accordance with the terms of the insurance policy Woking Shopmobility is responsible for the first £100 of any claims arising. This amount may be passed on to the person using the vehicle at the discretion of the Woking Shopmobility Administrator.
3. To wear straps as shown, where appropriate.
4. Not to carry babies, children or animals on the vehicle.
5. Not to use the vehicle on the roads except for the purpose of crossing.
6. To return the vehicle in good condition to Woking Shopmobility, in a fit and clean state.
7. To return the wheelchair or scooter to a member of Woking Shopmobility staff at a pre-arranged point at or before the time agreed.
8. To inform a member of Woking Shopmobility staff of any faults / problems with the vehicle used.
9. Due to Health and Safety regulations we are unable to offer assistance with lifting.
10. The management reserves the right to refuse a loan at their discretion. The management also reserves the right to vary the terms of the scheme at any time and will notify members as soon as possible.
11. To accept full responsibility against any claims made for material damage or personal injury by the third party.

I confirm that I do not have any condition which would impair my ability to safely operate the vehicle and I promise to inform Woking Shopmobility if there is any change in my condition which might affect my ability to safely operate the said equipment and agree to undertake a new assessment.

I acknowledge that Woking Shopmobility has a legitimate interest in using the information that I provide in order to provide me with services and to maintain its membership records. If you disclose any personal information relating to other people to us, you represent that you have the authority to do so and to permit us to use the information in accordance with this statement.
